IMPORTANT DATES

- August 9, 10 2008 -Field days
- August 12, 2008 - Coaches' meeting – Ivy Tech Auditorium: U6/U8 coaches 6-6:45pm, U10/12/15 coaches 7:15-8pm
- August 15, 2008 - Coaches should contact players by this date
- August 16, 2008 - Parents should contact GLRSA via e-mail if not contacted by coach by this date
- August 23, 2008 - First games for most teams
- October 11, 2008 - Last games for U10, U12, U15
- October 13, 2008 -Tourney week for U10, U12, U15
- October 18, 2008 - Last games for U6 and U8

GAME LOCATIONS

Playing fields will be determined prior to the start of the season. A list of game locations will be included in the

Coaches' packets. These will be Salisbury, CAT Park, and Davidson.

PRACTICE LOCATIONS

- 1) A list of practice locations will be included in the Coaches' packets.
- 2) Coaches determine practice times, days, and locations. Some practice locations involve reserving a date/time with a site coordinator.

SOCCER EQUIPMENT

- 1) Soccer shoes, no spikes (gym shoes okay).
- 2) Ball size – U6, U8, U10, and U12 – Size 4; U15 – Size 5.
- 3) Shin guards and socks
- 4) No jewelry or metal clips are to be worn during games/practices. Starter piercings must be taped.
- 5) All casts must be wrapped with ½ inch of foam in order to practice or play.
