Important Dates

PRACTICE LOCATIONS

- 1) A list of practice locations will be included in the Head Coach packet. Some practice locations involve reserving a date/time with a site coordinator.
- 2) **Head Coach determines practice times, days, and locations. GLRSA does not know when or where coaches will practice and cannot make roster changes due to conflicts with your schedule.**

SOCCER EQUIPMENT

- 1) Soccer shoes, no spikes (gym shoes okay).
- 2) Ball size: U6 = Size 3; U7, U8, U9, U10, U12 = Size 4; U15, U18 = Size 5.
- 3) Shin guards (required) and socks
- 4) No jewelry or metal clips are to be worn during games/practices. Starter piercings must be taped.
- 5) All casts must be wrapped with ½ inch of foam in order to practice or play.
